10. Agreement

Point-loss conditions

By signing, both teams confirm that they understand:

- The fixed deadline cannot be changed after approval.
- If both teams do not attend as required and present the completion form at the first in-person class after the deadline, **both teams lose the contract amount**.
- A team that breaks the contract pays **half of the agreed points** to the other team as compensation.
- The tutor may terminate the contract for misuse, unethical conduct, or inappropriate professional attitude.
- Course-process violations may cause a deduction of up to **twice the contract amount** from either or both teams.
- Deductions apply during final grading, and a negative balance cannot be ignored.
